Temporary Part Time Position

This position involves working as part of the Lloydminster Primary Care Network's Mental Health team to determine, advocate for, and attain appropriate community, provincial and federal resources and programs with a patient-centred approach. The position will run until March 31, 2023 with the possibility of extension.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Work collaboratively with other professionals to assess, plan and evaluate a care plan for patient's social needs.
- Provide solution-focused interventions and assist with practical matters such as navigating and accessing;
 - financial services (income options, form completion, budgeting, debt management),
 - medication coverage,
 - community resources (career and employment counseling, caregiver support, disability supports),
 - available housing.
- Provide short-term, mild-moderate counseling in the areas such as anxiety, self-efficacy, self-esteem, depression.
- Make appropriate referrals to other community, provincial, and federal services and resources.
- Assist clients in completion of agency forms that will help them access appropriate resources.
- Support patients in building capacity to self-manage their conditions and circumstances, and reach their health and wellness goals.

Qualifications/Skills

- Registered or ability to be registered with the Alberta College of Social Workers and Saskatchewan Association of Social Workers.
- 3-5 years of experience in the field of social work.
- Ability to work effectively in a multi-disciplinary team environment.
- Excellent written, verbal and interpersonal communication skills.
- Strong organizational skills.
- Strong analytical assessment and decision-making skills.
- Bachelor of Social Work considered an asset.
- Experience in a health care setting considered an asset.
- Previous use of an electronic medical record system considered an asset.
